 - Hanging and focusing fixtures
 - Assist with system programming and testing
- Work independently on-site to complete the above tasks
- Support system troubleshooting efforts under direction of the Engineer/Project Manager
- Maintain an organized workspace on-site which includes cleaning up debris, packaging material, equipment, and tools
- Work off-hours as needed to accommodate site availability/dark times (evening, weekends, etc.)
- Travel between work sites and office as needed to complete jobs in multiple locations

- Perform project pre-build, addressing, programming, or other prep work in the Protolight shop
- Help with gathering proper tools, PPE, and other equipment that will be needed on each job site
- Assist with deliveries of equipment if needed
